



Terms of Use

I. General

The data provided by [ISIN2LEI.eu](https://isin2lei.eu) is taken from open data sources.

The LEI data is taken from the The Global Legal Entity Identifier (LEI) System (www.gleif.org) and updated on a daily basis.

ISIN to LEI mappings are taken from the Financial Instruments Reference Data System (https://registers.esma.europa.eu/publication/searchRegister?core=esma_registers_firds) and at least updated at a weekly basis.

As of May 2019 ISIN to LEI mappings are also taken from the ISIN-to-LEI Relationship File that is made available by The Global Legal Entity Foundation and the Association of National Numbering Agencies. The sources of the data is stored in our database and made visible in the csv export files.

The purpose of [ISIN2LEI.eu](https://isin2lei.eu) is to link the source data and made it available in a user-friendly way.

A demo account offers up to 10 searches a daily free of charge. A Basic account doesn't have any searching limitations and a Pro account offers additional functionality such as personal favorite and ISIN and LEI upload possibilities.

Your account is personal. You may not share your username and password with any other person for any purpose. When an account is used by several persons, [ISIN2LEI.eu](https://isin2lei.eu) has the right to immediately terminate the subscription without any refund.
